Club Activities ...

- Organize event demonstrations
- Host 'Try It' days with mini set-ups for several different event types
- Plan 'Fun Days' as a group - have a 'PAWTY'!
- Hiking Trips or Group Walks in the community
- Lunch & Learns (eg: Breed Standard)
- Training Seminars
- Webinars

Community Engagement ...

- Host a 'Meet the Breed' or 'Educational Booth' at your local pet store, market or Pet Expo
- Schedule a school visit to introduce your breed
- Arrange to gate off a small area in a shopping mall parking lot and set up a mini 'demo station' for rally or agility
- Provide seasonally themed photos at a public space (Halloween, Fall, Spring, Winter)
- Volunteer assistance as a group for a charity
- Fundraise for local charities
- Invite visitors to club practices & events
- Attend youth group events such as 4-H or Girl Guides to present educational information
- Photo Contest
- Social Media Engagement
