
BY-LAWS ADDENDUM – BREED SPECIFIC RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

The breed specific Rules of Eligibility (ROE) shall be as follows:

Braque Francais (Varieties: Gascogne & Pyrenees)

Variety: Gascogne

Size: Medium/Large.

Coat Colour/Pattern: Chestnut, or white with chestnut speckles and/or patches.

Coat Texture/Length: Thick and smooth.

Body: Deep in profile with wide front and well ribbed; dewlap.

Ear Shape/Placement: Average length, high set, slightly folded, round at the tip.

Tail Shape/Carriage: Continues the convex line of the buttocks.

Unique Characteristics: Supple, fairly slack skin.

Feet: Compact.

Variety: Pyrenees

Size: Medium.

Coat Colour/Pattern: Chestnut, or white with chestnut speckles and/or patches.

Coat Texture/Length: Fine and short.

Body: Large and straight, a bit long; no dewlap.

Ear Shape/Placement: High set, barely folded.

Tail Shape/Carriage: Thin.

Unique Characteristics: Lighter structure of a rustic hound, convex back.

Feet: Lean.
